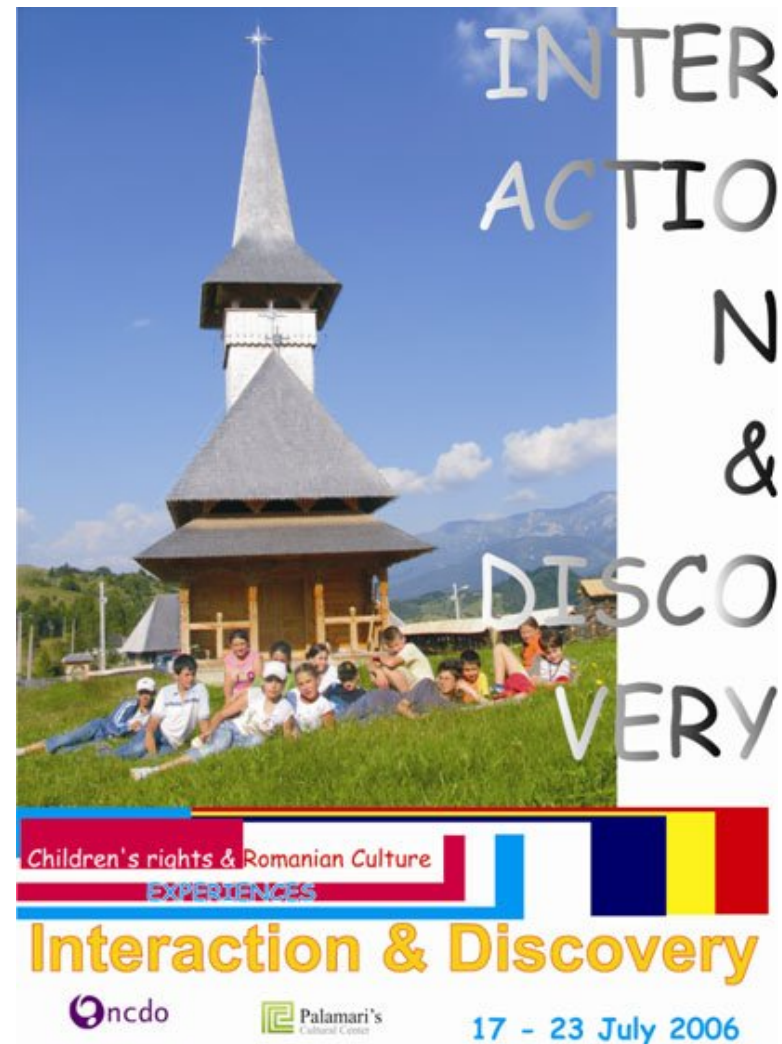
OBJECTIVES:

The key methods of teaching concentrated on:

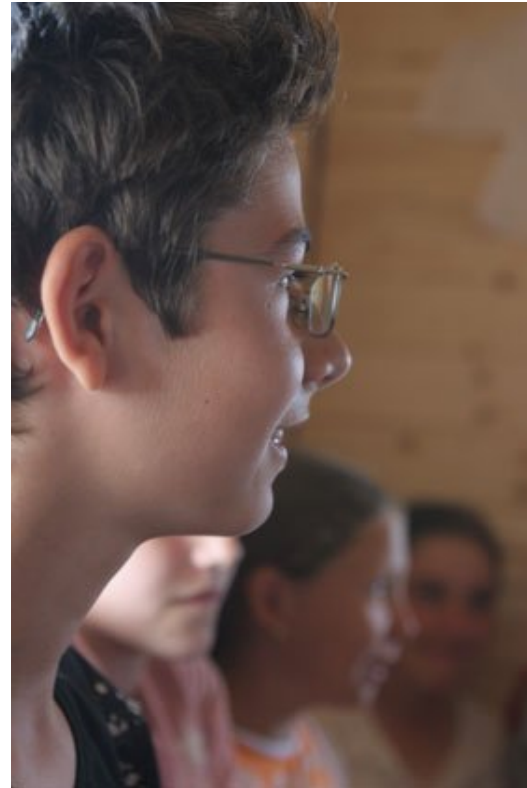


- the development of the ability of children to think freely;
